**Planned dates of start and end of the placement period:** 01. April 2013 – 31. August 2013

#### - Knowledge, skills and competence to be acquired:

- Learning about the outpatient dento-alveolar surgical treatment methods used in Germany
- Getting acquainted with the complex treatment of traumatised clients in operative dentistry
- Understanding the scheme for choosing relevant diagnostic algorithm, the most appropriate surgical and supplemental treatment as well as the post-treatment for clients with tumour disease
- Learning about the dysgnathe surgery
- Acquiring and getting acquainted with the different types of surgeries such as/for instance implantology and bone crafting, which are applied prior to prosthetic treatment in operative dentistry
- Learning about the plastic and reconstructive surgical aspects applied in everyday's operative dentistry practice
- Being able to select and use the appropriate medical imaging methods (such as CT, MRI, US) in practise

#### - Detailed programme of the training period:

- 2 months in the inpatient department
- 3 months in the outdoor patient department

#### - Tasks of the trainee:

- taking part in the everyday routine of the department
- taking part in the treatment of outdoor patients
- observing and assisting during patient examination
- observing and assisting during operations

#### - Monitoring and Mentoring of the participant:

- Home tutor revises work plan, host mentor provides daily supervision and consultation possibilities.
- Participant writes up a daily training log which is supervised and countersigned by the host mentor.

#### - Evaluation and Validation of the training placement:

- Evaluation and completion certificate will be issued by Mentor at the end of the training period.
